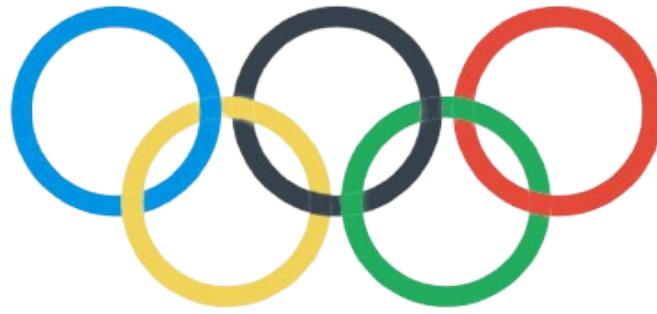

Students Entering Grades K-6 Enrollment Information

Let's go for Gold! This fun and short summer session will provide extra support for priority standards in Math and ELA, as well as fun enrichment activities to engage your child.

- This year, we will be using both of our elementary buildings for summer school (could change based on enrollment).
- Summer School enrollment is open to current De Soto students, **incoming Kindergarten students (students turning age 5 before August 1, 2024)**, and ANY student, even students who do not usually attend De Soto, by visiting the De Soto website at <http://www.desoto.k12.mo.us> under Enrolling Students → 2024 K-6 Summer School Registration.
 - Students who turn in their application by May 10 and attend the first three full days of summer school will be entered for a \$50 gift card drawing. A separate drawing is offered at each campus, so enroll today!
- We will be providing transportation this year.
- Students will be in attendance Monday-Friday, from 8:00 AM - 3:00 PM
- The program is FREE to all students, including students who attend other schools.

SUMMER SCHOOL DESCRIPTION:

The summer school program is operated by the De Soto School District to provide extended educational experience to students and prepare them for the next school year. The summer program is focused on offering increased engaging, enriching learning in a positive environment. The K-6 program will provide academic instruction on skills students need to review.

SUMMER SCHOOL SCHEDULE:

The summer school program runs June 3 and ends June 28. We will be on site Monday-Friday, from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Doors will not open until 8:00 am, at which time students can go to their classroom for breakfast. The day will consist of 90 minutes reading, 90 minutes writing, and 90 minutes math. Throughout the day, between each subject, students will be able to participate in games and/or projects based on their skill level.

ENROLLMENT:

FREE ACCOMMODATIONS:

The summer school program is FREE to all students. Students also receive a FREE breakfast and a FREE lunch daily.

ATTENDANCE:

Students do not have to be in attendance every hour of the program *to attend*. A child's occasional absence due to vacations, camps, etc., should not deter parents from enrolling their children into the K-6 program.

TRANSPORTATION:

We will be providing transportation for this summer session. Bus information will be available on the parent portal.
