Re: Summation of November 17, 2016 Board of Education Meeting

Please accept this communication as an abbreviated highlight of actions from the regular and executive sessions on November 17, 2016. The official board minutes will be posted on the District Communication page of the district website. The official minutes from each meeting are posted in the arrears by one month due to the approval of the minutes at the following board meeting.

District Report:

- Dr. Isaacson reported on October enrollment numbers for each grade-level and the total count of 182 students at ECC, 604 students at Athena, 808 students at Vineland, 448 students at DJHS, and 970 students at DHS, for a total of 3,012 students district-wide. A yearly comparison of AESOP absences, fill rates, and unfilled absences for both certified and classified staff was shared. Lastly, Dr. Isaacson reported receiving \$17,154 from a claim made on technology replacement items that were damaged by the storm on October 20, 2016.
- Mr. EA Boyer reported on progress on the junior high school, indicating that the elevator installation was being finalized and should be functional within a week. Mr. Boyer stated that the kitchen equipment, painting, and ceilings would be completed over the next several weeks. Mr. Boyer reported that sod placement in the front of the connecting corridor and the asphalt behind the junior high had been completed. The cafeteria will be ready for student use beginning on January 3, 2017.
- Mr. Patrick Lawlor reported that the Vineland gymnasium logo would be installed over the holiday weekend and that the majority of the Vineland punch list had been completed. Mr. Lawlor indicated that the auditorium project was moving along as the weather had been cooperative. Mr. Lawlor stated that masonry work on the fifty foot south wall had begun and fill would continue to be brought in to support the building of the walls.
- Mrs. Dow commended students and staff for hosting Veterans Day assemblies at each campus on November 11. Mrs. Dow highlighted the KJFF Radio interview by students Blake Lilge, Trista Grobe, and Roy Bradford along with Mrs. Mahn and Dr. Rickermann under the *News*, *What's New* tab on the district website.
- Mr. Ferrell reported on MSBA updates including upcoming legislative session and the prospects of future school funding.

- Mrs. Dow reported that the district earned 118.5 out of 140 points or 84.6% of the possible points on the APR, which was an increase of 9.6% from last year.
- Dr. Rickermann reported that De Soto High School earned 123 out of 140 points or 87.9% of the possible points on the APR. This was an increase over the 86.4% earned the prior year as a result of the 121 out of 140 points earned on the APR.
- Mrs. Mahn reported that De Soto Junior High School earned 50 out of 70 points or 71.4% of the possible points on the APR. This was an increase over the 70% earned the prior year as a result of the 49 out of 70 points earned on the APR.
- Mr. Grindstaff reported that Vineland earned 68 out of 70 points or 97.1% of the possible points on the APR. This was an increase over the 85.7% earned the prior year as a result of the 49 out of 70 points earned on the APR.
- Dr. Britain reported that Athena earned 52 out of 70 points or 74.3% of the possible points on the APR. This was an increase over the 64.3% earned the prior year as a result of the 45 out of 70 points earned on the APR.
- Mrs. Schmitz reported on the First Steps kindergarten results, including percentages for students on level based upon cognitive, language, and motor skills.
- Dr. Isaacson provided a summary on the results from the Listening and Learning Survey.
