SCHOOL LIAISON

COMTREA provides school liaisons, master's level counseling and social work professionals, to area schools and colleges.

SERVICES

- Individual or group counseling for students at the school- students become COMTREA clients
- Psycho-educational presentations in the classroom
- Staff, faculty, and parent consultation
- Support for individual education plans (IEP's) as needed
- Collaboration with physician for medication management
- Crisis response and assessment for students at risk of suicide or harm
- Behavioral Health Educational programming for CARE Teams, parent teacher organizations, etc
- Family support and resources along with appropriate referrals for family system wellness
- Training for school staff on topics including trauma awareness, resilience, classroom strategies, grief, anxiety, etc.
- Easy access to referrals to mental health services, dental care, and primary care
- School-based day treatment program

GROUP TOPICS AND RESOURCES

- Grief counseling
- Friendship issues
- Social skills
- Anxiety or anger management
- Divorce
- Topics as requested by the school staff

HOW IT WORKS

- An initial signed legal guardian consent form and then an intake packet are required for services
- Counselors coordinate with teachers and the school liaisons for a convenient time to meet with the student
- A school liaison will refer students to community resources if the circumstances cannot be effectively served in a schoolbased setting
